

Face gently receding, light yellowish. Thorax with a median reddish-brown stripe extending over the scutellum, divided in its anterior part by a narrow whitish line; on each side a stripe dusted with white extending over the side of the scutellum; laterally on each side there is another irregular brownish-red stripe bordered by whitish in front of the wings. Pleurae with brownish stripe, extending to beneath the poisers. Abdomen brown with paler lateral borders and narrow posterior margins of the segments. Legs obscurely yellowish-brown, hind femora with a number of short spine-like bristles underneath the distal halves;...
