At the end of 1680 Henry had been two and a half years in Oxford, without, as it would seem, having performed any of the public exercises necessary for his degree. On 11 March, 1681, he performed the exercise called answering under Batchlour, and on 30 June of the same year the exercise called generals. On 8 October, 1682, he underwent the Examination for his degree, and at the end of the year put on his gown. He was elected Tabiter on the first of December, and admitted on the sixteenth of the same month. He continued in Oxford, mainly occupied, it would seem, in reading Theology...
