They all have an inside iron grill and an outside oaken door, the latter being habitually fastened about one foot open, which enables the prisoner to hear but not to see whatever transpires in the corridor, including religious and choral services. Every prisoner receives a daily minimum of six visits, and in addition can call for and see any of the inspectors or principal officers whenever he wishes. When unprovided with profitable labor he has an hours walk...
